

# Scattering of ashes at sea.



## *A caring and memorable farewell to a loved one.*

Families and friends who wish to scatter the ashes of a loved one at sea can be assured of a caring service on board the MV Oceana.

We cruise in calm sheltered water and operate seven days a week, all year round.

Our service is flexible and there are a number of standard options available:

Oceana Charters collect and take the ashes to our private berth on North Wharf, from where we depart for the ceremony that day.

The bereaved (a maximum of 32 people) accompany the ashes and perform the



scattering themselves, or with assistance as required. This cruise takes approximately two hours and includes the serving of morning or afternoon tea.

A full scale wake (a maximum of 32 people) with a buffet meal and BYO alcohol. Our menus are available upon request. This cruise lasts four hours.

The port chaplains from the Protestant "Missions to Seamen" or Roman Catholic "Stella Maris" are available to conduct a short and appropriate service at the time of scattering, if required. A standard fee for their service applies. We are happy to arrange this for you.
